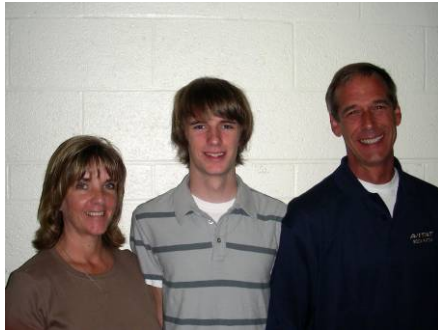
July 29, 2008-Meeting Notes

Tony Sculimbrene introduced today's program of **Jessie Duckro**, Program Manager of the **National Aviation Heritage Alliance** since 2005. A former music teacher decided to return

to school for her first love of History completing a Masters in Public History at Wright State University. Also present was a trustee of the Alliance and a Great Grand Niece of Wilbur Wright, **Amanda Wright Lane**. Jesse and Amanda both accompanied a Wright B Flyer replica to Farnborough England for an international air show in earlier in July.

In 2004 Congress recognized the Dayton region as the National Aviation Heritage Area, in honor of the region's leadership in our nation's aviation history includes eight southwest Ohio counties. The new National Aviation Heritage Area (NAHA) joins 26 other heritage areas in existence around the country.

Thanks to sponsorship by BAE Systems who recently acquire defense contractor MTC of Dayton the Aviation Heritage Area was able to send a replica 1911 Wright B Flyer known as the "Yellow Flyer" and some representatives to Farnborough Air Show, England. This replica did not fly at the show but had flown in the air in the past. An International Pioneers of Flight Pavilion held four accurate, full-scale replicas of the early 20th century aircraft. For the first time in history the Cody Flyer (1908), AVRO Biplane (1908) and AVRO Triplane (1910) and the Wright B Flyer (1911) were on display together under one roof for the first time. They also had a Wright B Flyer Flight Simulator. Surprising young children flew better than pilots who were too set in their ways. The simulator was very popular.



The Show attracted 1,500 exhibitors from 39 countries including all the major airplane manufactures and related businesses. Attendance was estimated to be 300,000 – 350,000. The Pioneer Pavilion was off the beaten track and left off the air show map but still had attendance in the 10,000 range.

Jesse finished with a quote about the role of the Aviation Heritage group:

It is not about dwelling on the past but about leveraging the past to create the future.
