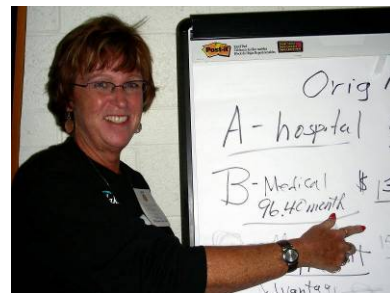
**Next Week's Program: Todd Reichley Chair:** Sez it will be a good one!
